#### 2015 SCCF-Wells Fargo Student Scholarship Information and Guidelines

- 1. Scholarships (up to \$250) will be awarded to students studying Chinese language and culture in public or private schools in the Great Sacramento Region.
- 2. Each current SCCF member school shall pre-screen the applications from their students, and submit the best two (2) to SCCF scholarship committee.
- 3. Individual students not attending any SCCF member schools can submit their own applications and compete separately for a pool of up to 8 individual scholarships.
- 4. Each student applicant must (when applicable):
  - > Submit a complete Application before the deadline.
  - ➤ Be currently enrolled in a Chinese language class or program for at least 6 months as of the deadline.
  - ➤ Be under 18 years old as of the deadline.
  - > Complete the application form, plus:
    - 1) Handwritten work in Chinese characters by applicant.
    - 2) A letter of recommendation from a principal, teacher, or prominent citizen who is not related.
    - 3) High school student applicants must also submit an essay describing any personal aspect of their life, and it has to be handwritten in Chinese characters and at least 200 characters long.
- 5. Scholarship winners will be determined by SCCF-WF Scholarship Committee, and be notified by e-mail before Aug. 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015
- 6. Each scholarship winner must be present and participate in a performance during the Scholarship Award Ceremony on Aug. 29<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

- 3. The School Grant winners will be selected by SCCF-WF Scholarship Committee, and the selection will be based on both the merit of the submitted application and the demonstrated school activities to promote Chinese language and culture in community throughout 2015.
- 4. Each winning school must have representatives present during the School Grant Announcement Ceremony (Date to be announced) to receive the Award Certificate.
- 5. The School Grant Check will be awarded directly to school representatives during the SCCF Annual General Membership Meeting (Date to be announced).
